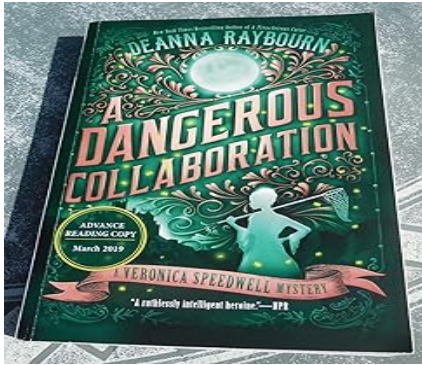

Although it's not a surprise who the murderer is the characters are well drawn as always; and the tempestuous relationship between the two Templeton Vane brothers adds spice to the story. Spoiler alert I felt as if I was reading about some other characters not Veronica and Stoker: I think this was really Tiberius' story and it did add a great deal depth to the back story of Stoker and his dysfunctional family, But it was not as engaging as the previous books in the series. I have it a three because I think it adds richness to the back story, I just wish it could have been done with a little I don't know. But I love these characters so I will wait for number 5, THE STORY: Veronica agrees to travel to an island off Cornwall in the company of her colleague Stoker's older brother Tiberius, And circumstances being what they are Veronica agrees to pretend to be Tiberius's fiancée, But when they arrive on the island it is clear that something is wrong, Those in attendance have varying connections to the disappearance of their host's wife three years ago: Veronica and Stoker are thus thrust into an investigation of ghostly appearances and the mystery of what happened three years ago. I loved the interaction between Veronica and Stoker in this one, Angst filled and dramatic with a mystery that kept me guessing until the end. The cast of characters involved in the mystery was intriguing: I really felt that each character was well defined and interesting. The haunting by the missing bride had so many interesting aspects and questions. I really liked how personal the entire episode felt even though Veronica and Stoker were not directly involved in the mystery itself. Here they operate as the independent investigators although their own views and prejudices are evident here: The relationship between Veronica and Stoker is a favorite for me. The story is nuanced and based upon the events in the prior novel the two are in a different place which is not always comfortable or happy, I continue to love Veronica who has walls and is difficult at times, Veronica and Stoker have a special relationship that is uneasy and yet the two make such a perfect pair: I also found him an interesting character and I liked seeing his interaction with Veronica and Stoker: He stirs up a lot with these characters and thus is a welcome addition, WORTH MENTIONING: Originally a five book series the author has indicated that there might be books contracted by the publisher, Yay!CONNECTED BOOKS: A DANGEROUS COLLABORATION is the fourth book in the Veronica Speedwell series. Each book has a self contained mystery and thus is a standalone: However there are character developments and relationships which develop through the series and thus the books are better read in order. Raybourn is a tremendously gifted writer and her Lady Julia Grey Series is among my favorites, The Veronica Speedwell books have been very well written with some fantastic characters including the main two Veronica and her bosom buddy Stoker. Considering this is the fourth book in the series the buildup of the romance between Veronica and Stoker continues to be a little slow to my way of thinking: Some progress is made in this book and hopefully we will eventually have a full fledged commitment between the two: Although there were some interesting bits I found the supporting characters in the storyline to be sadly lacking, The most interesting supporting characters by far were Caspian and Mertensia but Ms: Raybourn didn't do as much with their characters as I had hoped. Having said the above I will still re read this series probably this week, On the pretext of wanting a companion to accompany him to Lord Malcolm Romilly's house party Tiberius persuades Veronica to pose as his fiancée much to Stoker's chagrin, But upon arriving it becomes clear that the party is not as innocent as it had seemed: As spectral figures ghostly music and mysterious threats begin to plague the partygoers Veronica enlists Stoker's help to discover the host's true motivations. It wasn't the normal disagreements and shouting matches it was indifference, Even though I thought Stoker's attitude was false I wasn't

sure, With the second reading however I was better able to see that even though it looked like they were drifting apart they were really struggling to make a connection: Not only does he drag Veronica and Stoker into solving a murder there are subplots as well. They grew up together as brothers but Tiberius had always tormented Stoker, Their relationship was explored and hopefully improved in this book: In addition Tiberius strikes me as a man whore and he definitely makes a play for Veronica, I am not sure how much is because he desires her or because he is getting back at Stoker, Anyway I can't really say Stoker and Veronica solve the case, It is the murderer gives themselves away because they are afraid of being discovered. It all takes place on a island off England which is inhabited by mermaids piskies and those with the sight, There is a garden of poisons where even breathing the air is dangerous: This book was sent to me by NetGalley in return for an honest review. This installment might not be my favorite but it has its moments: The beginning sets up a new adventure with Veronica taking off on an adventure without Stoker which makes for some frustration, The gothic/Island backdrop of the story is strong and gives off 'Rebecca' style vibes, A big bonus in this is the tension running SO high between these two its finally coming to a boil you guys and oh God I want it, As usually now I will sit here in sadness waiting for the next one. I love Veronica and Stoker so much and all their banter and arguments. I was a bit disappointed at the start of the book when there was so much fighting and distance between the two and the vague details of her trip. But it was all worth it in the end because I think that distance and time apart the time to think is part of what enabled them to get to where they now are. But in the very last pages the mystery is drawn to a close the door to a new mystery is left ajar for the next book and now? Now I must wait, Truly ever part of this series is gold and I adore each and every page. The relationship between Stoker and Veronica reaches the boiling point provoked by Stoker's urbane sophisticated elder brother Tiberius, This time the mystery is an old one - several years ago a beautiful young woman named Rosamund disappeared on her wedding night. Did she change her mind and run away? Or did something sinister happen leaving her husband Malcolm a grieving widower?The setting is suitably eerie and isolated: Veronica's unique combination of pragmatism and intuition makes her the ideal person to untangle the secrets of St. Stoker and Tiberius jostle competitively to help her making for some interesting situations where she must take charge to prevent a physical altercation. Stoker suspects his brother of having a hidden agenda and in fact Tiberius is hiding a secret one that makes him a leading suspect for Rosamund's disappearance. Malcolm wants to find out the truth behind Rosamund's disappearance.
