Arundhati Roy Okay first things first. This book has structure. Lots of it. 'The secret of being a bore is to tell everything.' Voltaire said. And the Really Big Things. And how. And how much. And how long. About our lives not really being in our hands. In short a History lesson. Us and them. Really. Arundhati Roy That's what careless words do. They make people love you a little less. The novel follows a multi-generational Indian family in 1969. The matriarch Mammachi is their abused and blind grandmother. And the air was full of Thoughts and Things to Say. I couldn't follow a thing. The prose was overly complicated and tiresome to read. I love beautiful language and elegant metaphors. So much metaphor time absolutely no character development. And in general the plot was one giant grey mess. Ultimately it's one very confused star. Not a fan of this one. And yet I really didn't like it. It's not a bad book - far from it. A subtle hand will always serve you better I think. I mean like that only nice. Potentially ripe with e coli. Estha doesn't talk any more. He's got a mom too. This is what their garden is like. Brick walls turn mossgreen. Pepper vines snake up electric poles. Wild creepers burst through laterite banks. Black crows gorge on bright mangoes.like ideas in the evenings. P A dazzling way with language doesn't hurt either. And how much. It won the Booker Prize in 1997. The writing is self-conscious and precious. Too much effort too little editing. Their family life is told. It won the Booker prize and is very satisfying. Derelict. Abandoned. Forgotten.But I remember. I remember Chacko and Sophie Mol. Ammu and Velutha. Rahel and

Estha. And most of all I remember You. You ask for things so heedlessly so powerfully. The right to love whom we want and how much we want. The right to be equal.
